- Provide clarity to the process



# ISSUES MANAGEMENT PROCESS

## HOW ISSUES ARE RAISED

- Raised and sponsored by the PSC member organizations
- Identified independently through the PSC discussion
- Raised by others not represented on the PSC



# ISSUES MANAGEMENT PROCESS

## STEPS IN PROCESS

### Issues Identification:

- Organization identifies issue
- Determines appropriateness for PSC
- Commits to sponsor



# ISSUES MANAGEMENT PROCESS

## STEP IN PROCESS ....continued

### Notification and Preliminary Review:

- Sponsor's proposal to PSC



# ISSUES MANAGEMENT PROCESS

## STEP IN PROCESS ....continued

### Member Review and Ratification:

- Member organization's review proposal ( in consultation with their principals) To determine:
  - Support PSC pursuing the issue
  - Oppose the proposal
  - Support the proposal on certain conditions
  - Abstain

### Decision making:

- By Consensus

## PROPOSAL SUBMISSION INCLUDES:

- Issue To Be Sponsored
- Individual Responsible For The Project
- Start Of The Initiative
- Target date For Completion
- Estimated Budget Required
- Assistance sought From Other Members Of The Council
- Desired Outcome For The Project
- Marketing/Distribution
